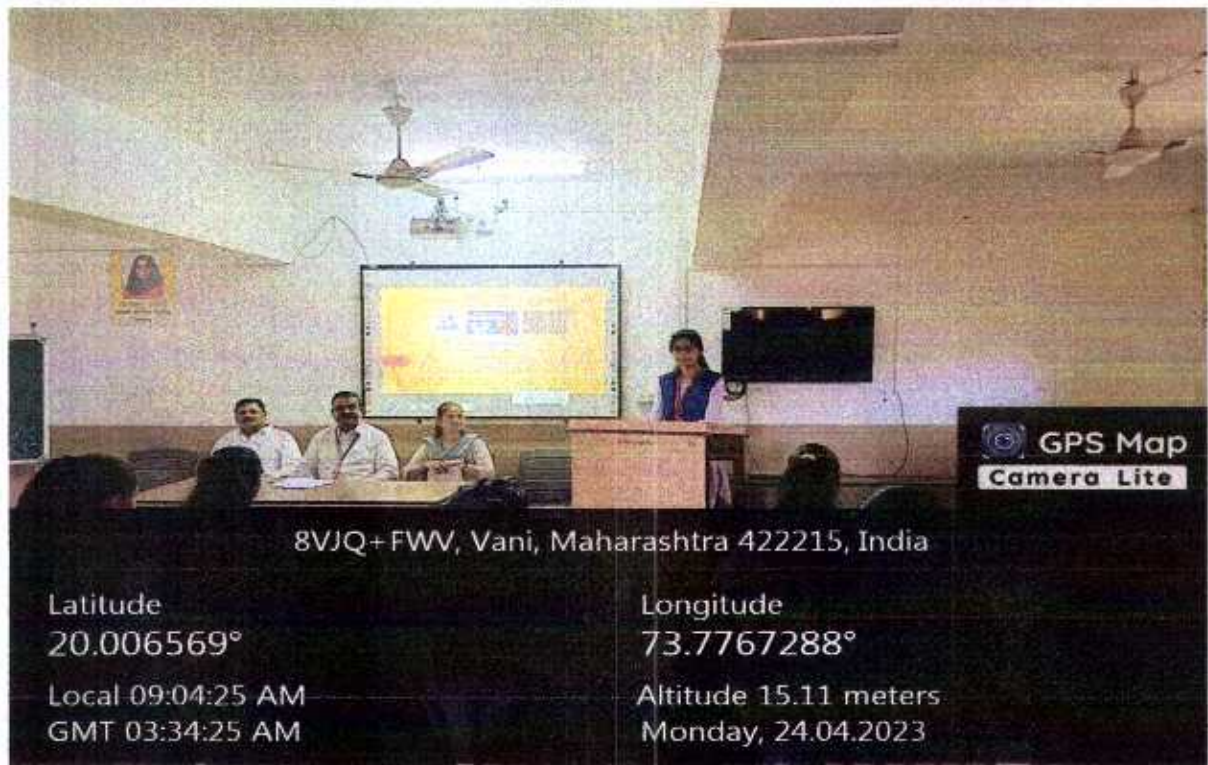

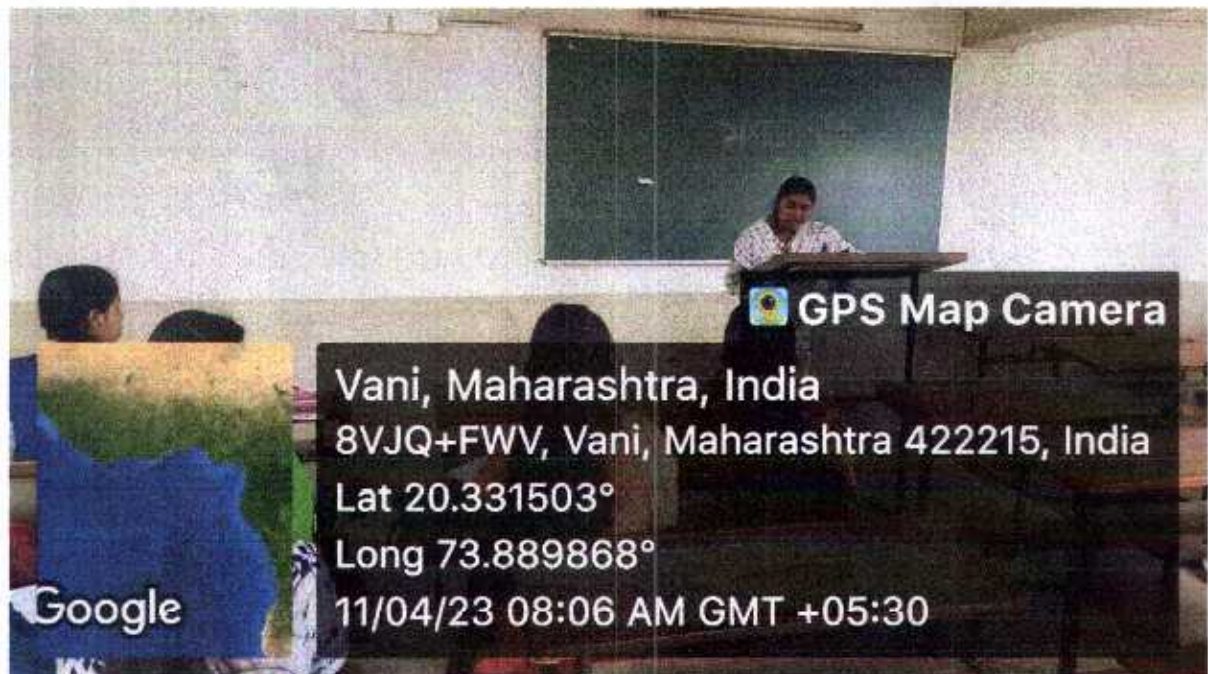

**3) The Context: –**

In the academic year, 2022-23 under the guidance of principal Dr. R.N.Bhavare, Karmaveer Raosaheb Thorat Arts, Commerce and Science College Vani, has conducted a new voter registration campaign from on 03/12/2022 Tuesday in our college.. 25th January 2021 was celebrated as National voters' day as a part of the new voter registration campaign.

This Democracy Week was celebrated with various activities in the college. Also, under the guidance of the Government of Maharashtra. The notice was displayed on the notice board regarding the new voter registration process. The students of first year B. A/ B.Com/ B.Sc. who have completed 18 years of their age were provided with form number- 6 . Students were guided to fill in the form and were asked to attach the necessary documents. The complete filled form number- 6 was submitted to the department of political science. In this new voter registration campaign total of 27 out of 17 boys and 10 girls became eligible for registration. The complete form and the list of the students were submitted in the tahsildar office Dindori.

Throughout this campaign, the students will get a voter ID card from the Tahsil by post all of the registered students will get the right of voting. 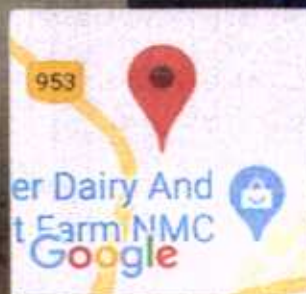

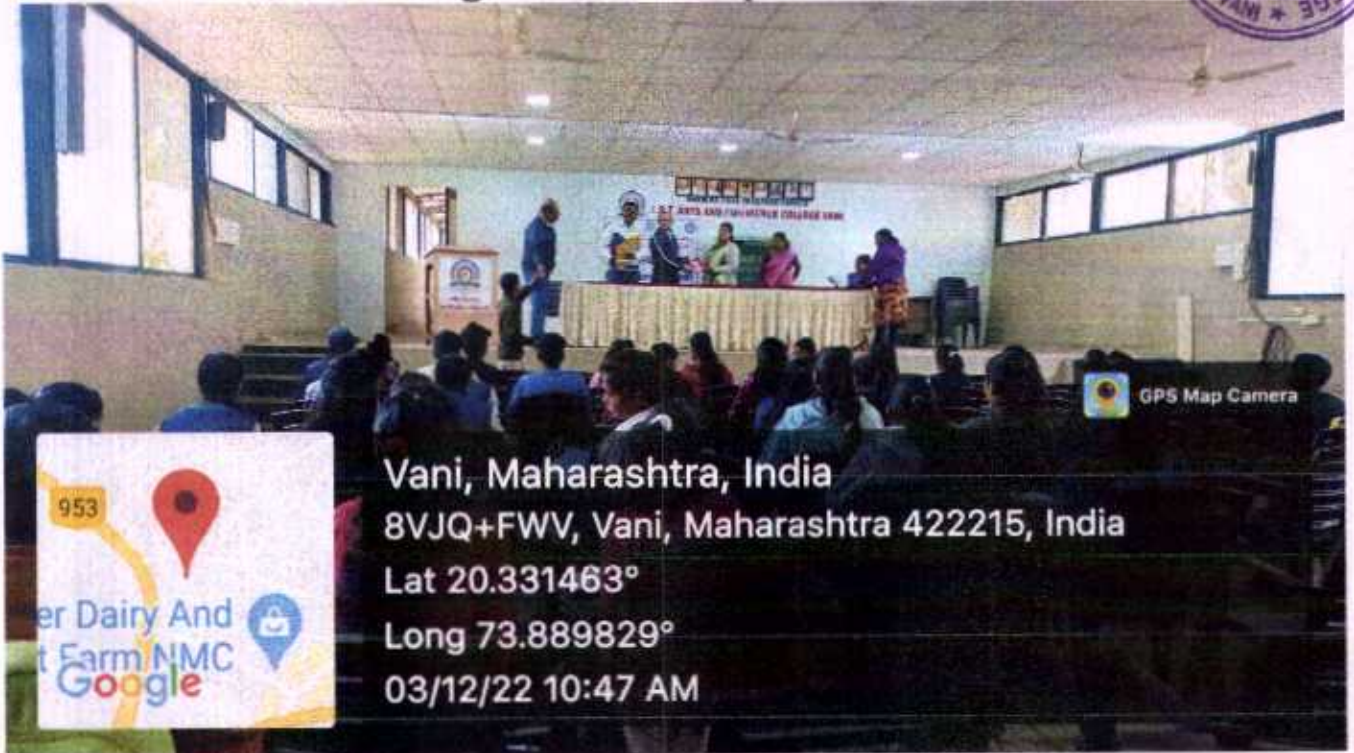

For the said program thirty six student and staff members were present all had participated eagerly. In this programme twenty one students were participate.

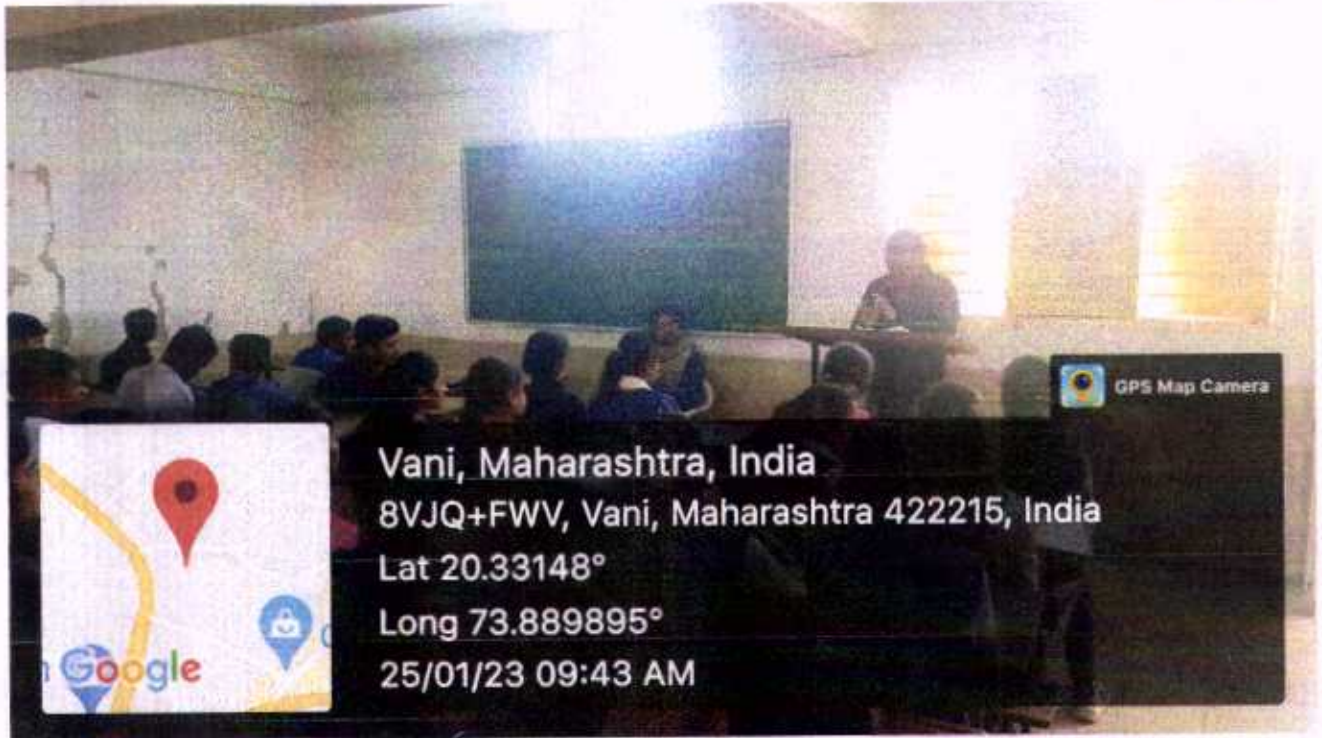
